I have also been employed as an academician in the Department of Economics at Vanderbilt University, Adnan Menderes University, Izmir University of Economics (part-time) and University of California-Santa Cruz (research fellow), where I taught undergraduate and graduate courses in Econometrics, Statistics, Financial Economics, Managerial Economics, Quantitative Methods, Game Theory and Mathematical Economics. My research is generally focused on the efficiency, competition, risk and stability of financial institutions. I have also published a couple of papers on the volatility and forecasting of financial variables. Recently, I have started doing research on energy economics, and published a couple of papers in this field. My published papers have appeared in International Business Review, Empirical Economics, Economic Modelling, Applied Economics, Emerging Market Review, Journal of International Financial Markets, Institutions & Money, Economic Systems, The North American Journal of Economics and Finance, Journal of Applied Economics, Empirica, Physica A, Energy Economics, Energy, Environmental Science and Pollution Research, Bulletin of Economic Research, Emerging Markets Trade and Finance, International Review of Applied Economics and International Journal of the Economics of Business.
